1 February 2026

Dear brothers and sisters,

This Sunday at the 10am Mass at Katoomba there will be a rarely seen ceremony, the Blessing of the Bells.

The bells which are to be put up in the Bell Tower at St Canice's Church will be blessed with Holy Water, prayed over, anointed and incensed because

they serve a very important purpose. They call people to synchronise our lives with the heartbeat of Christ, the heartbeat of Christ's Body the Church.

The bells are sacramentals, like Holy Oils, they are signs, in this case not visible but audible to something that is happening that we cannot hear or see.


These bells will not only call people to Mass, but they will also announce weddings and funerals and if it would be possible to ring them throughout the day, they would mark the hours of the day including the ringing out of the hours of the Angelus. In this way all who hear them are exposed to the Beating Heart of the Church. It is here that the bells also have another function, that of protection, because as they sound out, they drive the forces of evil from the Parish. The forces that are opposed to Christ and His church.

What we will see this Sunday is a great and memorable ceremony, but what follows will be a great blessing for our Parish, for these Bells will bring many, most probably unseen, blessings to not only the people that live in the geographic area of the Parish but also plants, animals and the land, all things that exist under their protective sound.


The Sacred Heart of Jesus Treble Bell (No.1)




